1 Eccles St
35 Eccles Street, home of James Haughton, one of Frederick's hosts.

2 Rutland Square
Rotunda Meeting Rooms - where many abolitionists spoke.

3 Abbey St
Music Hall
Abbey St. - lecture.

4 North Wall
Epic Museum / National Famine way marker.

5 Burgh Quay
O'Connell Statue, near Burgh Quay - site of Conciliation Hall (now demolished) and meeting with Daniel O'Connell.

9 Eustace St
Friends' Meeting Room,
Eustace St - lecture.

6 Westland Row
Pearse Street (formerly Great Brunswick Street) - where Frederick stayed.

10 Dame St
City Hall (formerly, the Royal Exchange), Dame St - Frederick's first lecture.

8 Dawson St
Mansion House, Dawson Street - where Frederick dined with the Lord Mayor.

7 Merrion Sq
58 Merrion Sq, home of Daniel O'Connell.
